

DD 467 HISTORY

This year 2023, marks the 80th anniversary of the loss of DD467.

On 16 June, 1943, Strong shot down 3 attacking Japanese planes.

On 5 July, 1943, while in battle at Bairoko Harbor, New Georgia, in Solomon Islands, she is sunk by Torpedo from Japanese destroyer, taking 46 men down with her.

241 men were rescued by the USS Chavalier DD451.

On 6 February, 2019 the RV Petrel, a Paul Allen search vessel discovered the wreckage of DD467.

Ens. Billy Clay Hendrick Jr.

-Went down with ship, along with 45 others, while he was securing communications equipment.

Edward Deering

Went down with ship while securing equipment below.

Ens. Milton Hackett (Chief Torpedo Officer)

- Survived blast, and pulled several men out of water onto float net, including Hugh Barr Miller, and Jim Merriman. Past away in 2013.

DD 467 History continued

Lt. Hugh Barr Miller Jr.

-Gunnery officer, part of 23 survivors in water after the ship sunk. Past away in 1978.

BMC Stanley Hoder (Andy's dad)

-Survived sinking, and passed away in 2011.

Cdr. Gus Wellings (467 Skipper)

-Survived sinking, and was picked up, and then injured by explosions from Strong, while in raft.
